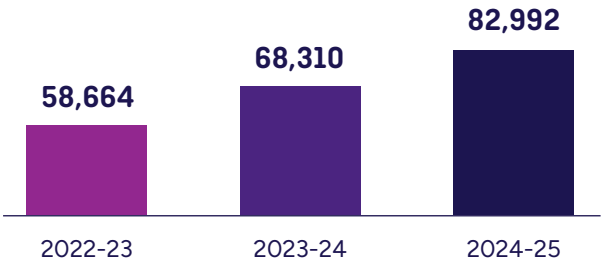
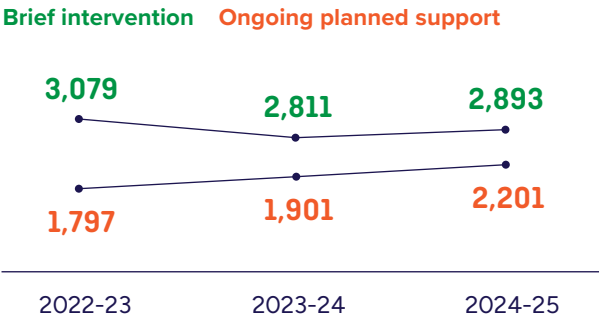




3 YEAR COMPARISON – OCCASIONS OF SUPPORT

4% gender diverse

11% culturally and linguistically diverse
The most common countries of birth, outside of Australia, were New Zealand, Papua New Guinea, England, China, and South Africa.

30% were young parents

196 children were supported aged between birth and 11 years old, along with their young parent(s).

The most common languages spoken at home other than English were Somali, Swahili, Persian, Korean, Tok Pisin (Neomelanesian), and Mandarin.

20% of young parents were caring for a new baby when they connected with BYS.
